

Where's the bus?

The weather is bad. There's snow, ice, freezing temperatures. None of which is good for a bus. None of it is very good for children either.

Our goal is to expose your child to the least bad weather while getting our buses to every stop as efficiently as possible.

In years past, this was hit or miss. Today, with new technology, we can give you the ability to adjust when your child arrives at the bus stop when weather conditions are difficult. It is called SafeStop.

SafeStop is an application available from the Apple Store or Google Play. And, it is free.

Once you download the SafeStop application, registering is simple. The student number you are required to enter is your child's school lunch number. If you or your child do not know the number, please call your child's school. There are complete instructions for using SafeStop at www.safestopapp.com/safe_stop/user_guide

One note of caution...

SafeStop is not designed to allow your child to arrive at the bus stop at the last second. Please have the child arrive five to ten minutes before the scheduled arrival of the bus. It benefits every child, including your own, to have the buses operate as efficiently as possible.
