

Waddington and Oldham School Reorganization



Benefits of Reorganization

- Departmentalized classes – Grades 3-5
 - Currently Oldham cannot departmentalize and Waddington has to split 3 ways instead of 2
- Many RIDE initiatives require minimum of 2 classes (i.e. Boston Kindergarten)
- Teacher collaboration across grade level – Horizontal articulation
- Establishment of 3 new Pre-K classes – additional 60 students – currently 23 on waiting list.
- Before and After School Day Care



Waddington Drop Off and Pick-Up

- Arrival (Parent Drop Off)
 - Grade K-1 Dropped off at front left of building
 - Grades 2-5 – Dropped off in back of school
- Arrival by Bus
 - All students will be dropped off on the right side of the building with help of Safety Patrol and 4 Kindergarten Aides.
 - 1st grade students will go to blacktop area (1st grade courtyard)
 - All other students will stay at the rear of the building
- Dismissal (Parent Pick-Up)
 - Parents of K-1 Students will park in the front of the building and pick up students at their classroom doors
 - Parents of students in 2-5 will continue to pick up students at the back of the building
- Dismissal by Bus
 - Students will continue to line up in the gym and exit through the side door



Waddington Itinerant Sample Schedule

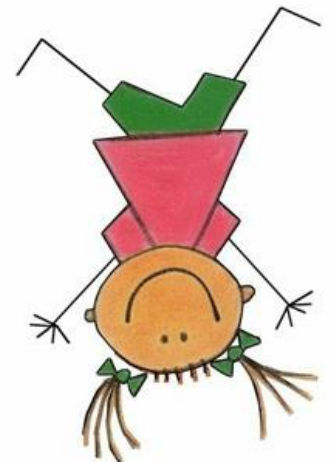

- All Grade K-5 Teachers will have a Common Prep period
- Itinerants will continue to have weekly Common Planning time with other itinerants in the district.



Waddington Enrollment

- Current Waddington Enrollment:
 - Grades K–5 – 415 Students
 - Pre-K – 91 Students
 - TOTAL – 506 students
- Oldham Students moving to Waddington
 - Grades K-5 – 144 Students
- 2019-20 Waddington Enrollment
 - $506 - 91 + 144 = 559$ students
 - Net Increase = 56 Students



Staff Movement

- Oldham to Waddington – 14 staff
 - 6 Teachers (K-5)
 - Math Interventionist and Reading Teacher
 - Social Worker, .5 Psychologist, .4 Speech Pathologist
 - Resource Teacher
 - 2 Para-Professionals
 - 2 Supervisory Aides
 - OT – PT – Time Increase for student needs
- Waddington to Oldham – 21 staff
 - Special Ed Pre-K Director
 - Special Ed Pre-K Secretary
 - 5 Teachers (Special Ed Pre-K)
 - 7 Para-Professionals
 - 2 Speech Pathologists – 1 Psychologist
 - .5 Social Worker – 2 OT – 1 PT

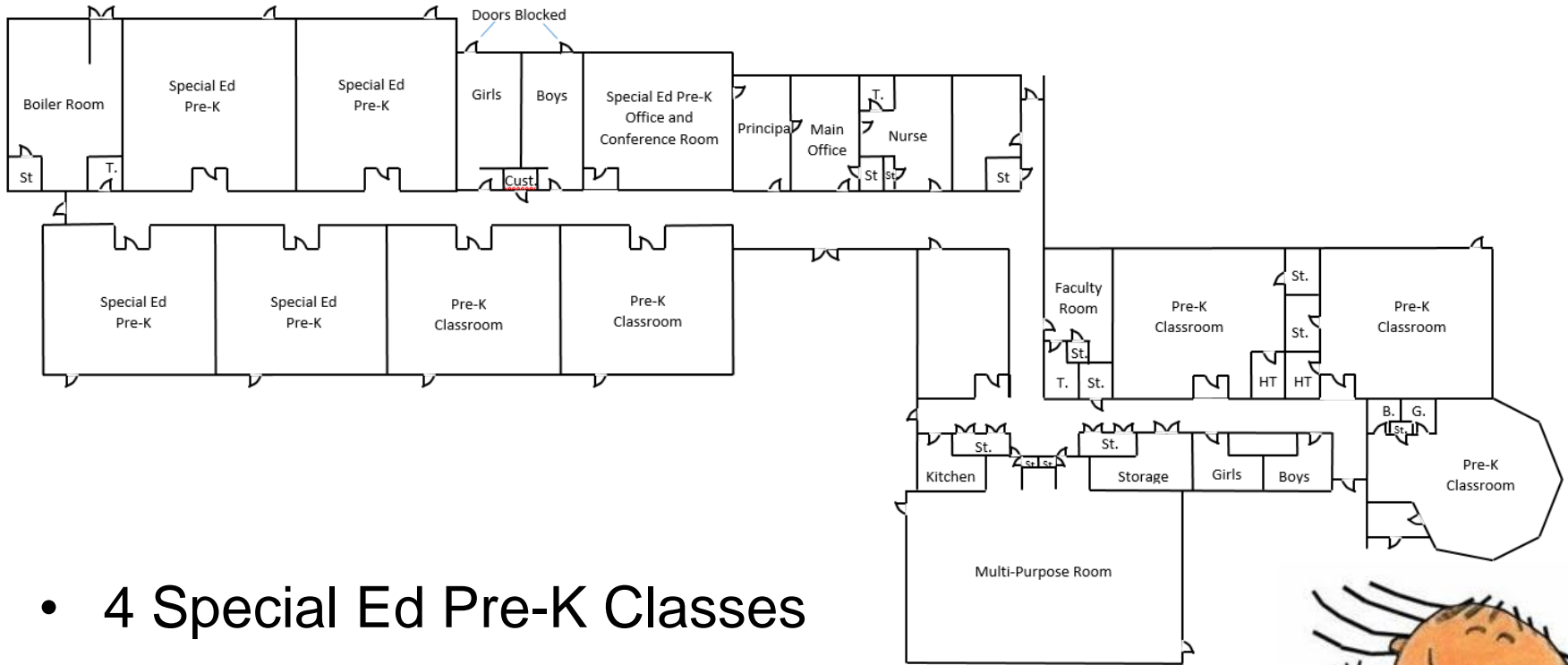


Waddington Parking and Lunch

- Parking – Gaining 7 Parking Spots with staff movement
- Bussing – Gaining 3 Additional Oldham Buses – Losing 3 Pre-K Buses 4 x a day
- Lunch – Currently 3 Lunches
- Lunch Capacity 221 students with tables and chairs during the day.
- 3 Lunch periods can accommodate 663 students – New Enrollment 559 students
- Gymnasium (3320 ft²) capacity w/o tables and chairs – 474 people for school functions
