HAVE SYMPTOMS OF ANY ILLNESS

- Cough - Fever or chills
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Muscle or body aches - Sore throat
 - Headache - Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea - Runny nose or stuffy nose
- Fatigue - Recent loss of taste or smell

CANNOT go to school

**ASYMPTOMATIC
(NO SYMPTOMS PRESENT)**
NO COVID-19 DIAGNOSIS
NO CLOSE CONTACT TO COVID-19

CAN go to school

STUDENTS/STAFF THAT TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

Five-Day Isolation Required

The first day of isolation is the day after the positive test or start of symptoms. May return to school when:
No symptoms or symptoms are improving **AND** fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication
*must wear a well-fitting mask at home and with others.

CLOSE CONTACT (HOUSEHOLD)

UNVACCINATED

Need to quarantine for 5 days from last exposure
Need to participate in a daily rapid antigen test for an additional 5 days in school

VACCINATED

Need to participate in a daily rapid antigen test for 5 days in school
If they have symptoms they must stay home and get a PCR test

CLOSE CONTACT (Non-household)

UNVACCINATED/Not up to date on vaccinations

Both the contact and the COVID-19 case were consistently masked
No Symptoms

VACCINATED

Monitor for symptoms

Monitor to Stay
